- M.Sc/ MA in Social Work / Dalit Studies/ Sociology / Political Science / Economic (M. Phil/ PhD Candidates will be Preferred)
- Must Have good knowledge of basic statistical techniques and statistical software like STATA/SPSS
- Must Have Written & Spoken competency in English & Marathi Languages.
- Candidates having experience, will be given preference.
- Age Criteria : 24 -40 years

Remuneration/Salary: Consolidated payment of Rs.50,000/-per Month +Traveling expenses during data collection by public transport.

Responsibilities:

- Designing Questionnaire
- Engage/Facilitate data collection through a household survey/Focus Group Discussion /Case studies/ Secondary sources
- Field visits in Dharashiv district, Maharashtra.

- Basic Analysis, tabulation and interpretation of large survey data.
- Report writing and documentation of data.
- Identification of key informants from various stake holders and conduct of qualitative interviews.
- Helping the PI for preparing the initial draft report.
