

Admission to Hostels : 2025-2026 (Only for one Academic year)

Considering the limited number of seats available in the hostels in TISS-Mumbai, the following criteria will be followed for hostel accommodation

I. PG First Year: (2025-2027 Batch) and B.Ed-M.Ed. Programs

- a. The first-year students - SC/ST students with an annual income less than 2.5 lakhs and OBC/EWS/Gen with an annual income less than 1 lakh. The students have to submit the valid income certificate issued by the competent authorities like Revenue Officer, Tahsildar, Block Development Officer or the District Magistrate/Collector of the respective state government.
- b. The students must also submit residence proof, the last six month's electricity bill, and the ration card of their household.
- c. The first-year students who are **not eligible for hostel accommodation.**
 - * Annual Household income SC/ST students with an annual income above 2.5 lakhs and OBC/EWS/Gen with an annual income above than 1 lakh.
 - * Ordinarily reside in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region, extending up to Karjat, Kasara, Virar, and Panvel.
 - * Deputed Candidates/Candidates on-study leave
 - * Employed during the period of study at TISS.
 - * The students who repeat their semester
 - * The students who are applying for a second Master's program

II. PG Second Years: (2024-2026 Batch)

(a) All the second-year eligible GOI-PMS students-SC/ST students with an annual income less than 2.5 lakhs and OBC with an annual income less than 1 lakh. Endorsed by E.O.C

(b) All students with an annual income of one lakh, must apply with the following documents-residence proof, the last six month's electricity bill, the ration card of their household.

(c) And all the points of I (c) will be applicable.

III. UG first years: (2025-2029 Batch)

All first year students are eligible for hostel. For the BSW second year students hostel accommodation is available only to those whose annual income is less than 1 lakh across all categories and also those who are below 18 years of age and all the points of I (c) and II (b) will be applicable.

IV. All Persons with disability, with the necessary documents from authorized professionals. Those who do not have disability certificate as per PWD Act 2016, should submit the same within six months period from the time of admission.

V. Self-financing programs are not eligible for Hostel Accommodation.

VI. Ph.D scholars (2025-2028): All the points of I (a), (b) and (c) will be applicable and the allotment will be only for one academic year and the committee will review the application for the 2nd year.

Admission Procedure: All students must submit application through online portal for the hostel accommodation. Students who are eligible for hostel accommodation will be informed over mail or displayed their names on the website. The selected students will have to pay the hostel fees. After submitting the hostel fees payment, they shall be allotted hostel room number. Those who are not paying the fees within the deadline their hostel admission will be cancelled and the same seat be given to the waiting list students.

The decision of the Hostel Committee for the allotments will be final.
