Required Assistant Professor (One Post) on Contract Basis for School of Gender Studies, TISS Hyderabad Off-campus

The Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), established in 1936, is a centrally funded public university and recognized as a premier institution for social sciences education. The Institute has now grown into a multi-campus public university that is today offering over 100 different cutting-edge programmes from its campuses at Mumbai, Tuljapur, Hyderabad and Guwahati. The Hyderabad campus was set up in 2011 and currently has 4 Schools that offer 6 Master's and 2 doctoral research programmes.

The School of Gender Studies in the Hyderabad campus was established (a) to serve as a catalyst for social transformation, (b) to develop professional expertise to use gender as an analytical category in research, teaching, social policy and planning and outreach programmes and (c) to partner with Government, industry, and civil society in promoting gender sensitivity, equality, and equity. The uniqueness of the school is that it draws upon a broad range of disciplinary approaches to the study of women and gender. It seeks to bring synthesis between feminist understanding and knowledge and the core commitment of TISS to promotion of sustainable, equitable, and participatory development, and social justice. The School offers a two-year MA in Women's Studies with wide-ranging courses.

The School of Gender Studies invites applications for **ONE** post of **Assistant Professor** on contract basis, initially for a period of one year. The applicant will be required to teach courses such as Women and Work, Gender in Development Practice and Women's Movements.

Pay Scale: Consolidated Salary of Rs. 71952/- p.m.

Eligibility Criteria:

Educational Qualification: Eligibility (A or B) :

A.

i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Social Sciences or Humanities from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test

accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. Candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET /SLET /SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor subject to the or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions fulfillment of the following conditions :-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Desirable Qualification:

Ph. D. in Social Sciences or Humanities and/or Two years of Teaching experience in the relevant discipline.

Application fee: The application fee of Rs. 1000/- be paid on-line. The SC/ST/PWD candidates will have to pay an application fee of Rs. 100/- if they attach the required certificate to the online application form. The application will be considered valid only on receipt of the application fee. Fees once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

Last date for submission of online applications: June 15, 2020

Interview: The eligible candidates will be communicated by an e-mail and mobile phone to appear for the presentation and interview to be conducted at TISS, Hyderabad Campus.

Other Conditions:

- The Institute reserves the right to relax qualification of the candidate based on the work experience and to relax age in the case of persons already holding comparable positions in a University/Research Institution of repute.
- The Institute reserves the right to invite persons for interview who may not have applied for as per the above procedure and not fill up the vacancy advertised.
- Since applications received may be short listed, merely possessing the prescribed qualifications and the requisite experience would not entitle a person to be called for interview.
- The post is unreserved, but candidates belonging to reserved category can apply.
- No queries or correspondence regarding issue of call letter for interview/selection of candidates for the post will be entertained at any stage and canvassing in any form is strictly prohibited and will lead to the candidate being debarred from consideration for the post.
- The candidate under employment must bring 'No Objection Certificate' from their employer to appear for presentation/interview.
