

## Internship Opportunities

TANDA (Towards Advocacy Networking and Developmental Action) was initiated through student field work placements by the Centre for Criminology and Justice (CCJ), TISS in 2009.<sup>1</sup> Later in 2011, a field action project named TANDA was started to work on the issue of NTDNT. TANDA works on non-formal education with children and adult through Community learning centres and women's collectives. Apart from this, TANDA is also engaged in research and advocacy on the issue.
